Key principles for: Citizens

- Engage with your representatives early in the process and follow up.
- Ensure all members of your community have a strong joint vision for its future which informs its development priorities.
- Engage with your representatives who are responsible for voicing your community's issues: Members of the County Assembly in the County Assembly and your MPs, County Women Reps and Senators in the National Assembly and Senate.

County Government/Representatives

- Involve citizens at all levels in consultations, including vulnerable and marginalized groups.
- Explain clearly the process of planning and budgeting and how citizens priorities will be incorporated.
- Follow through on any promises and make sure that you provide the community with feedback/updates on the process.



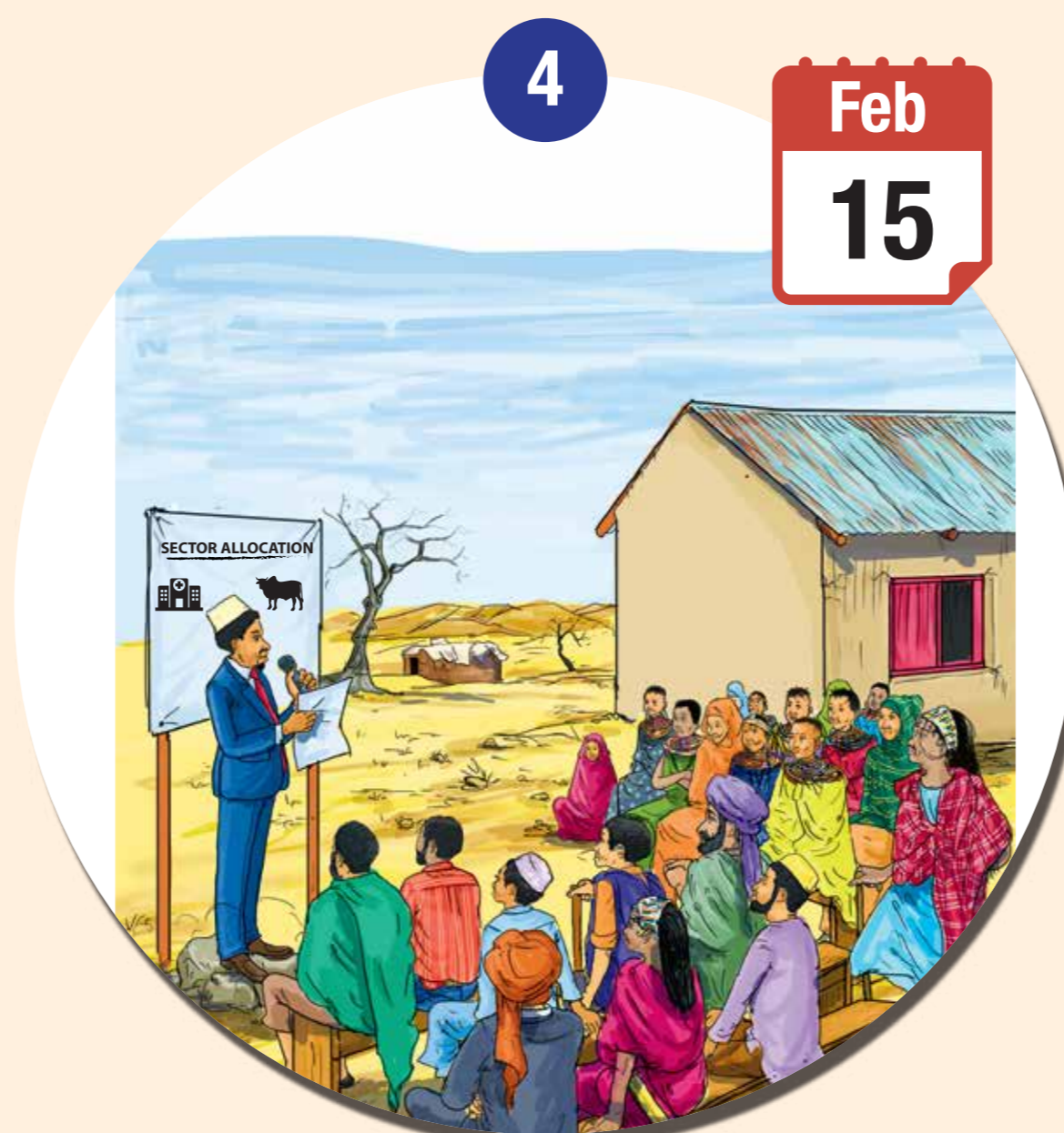
County Budget Committee begins hearings on budget estimates



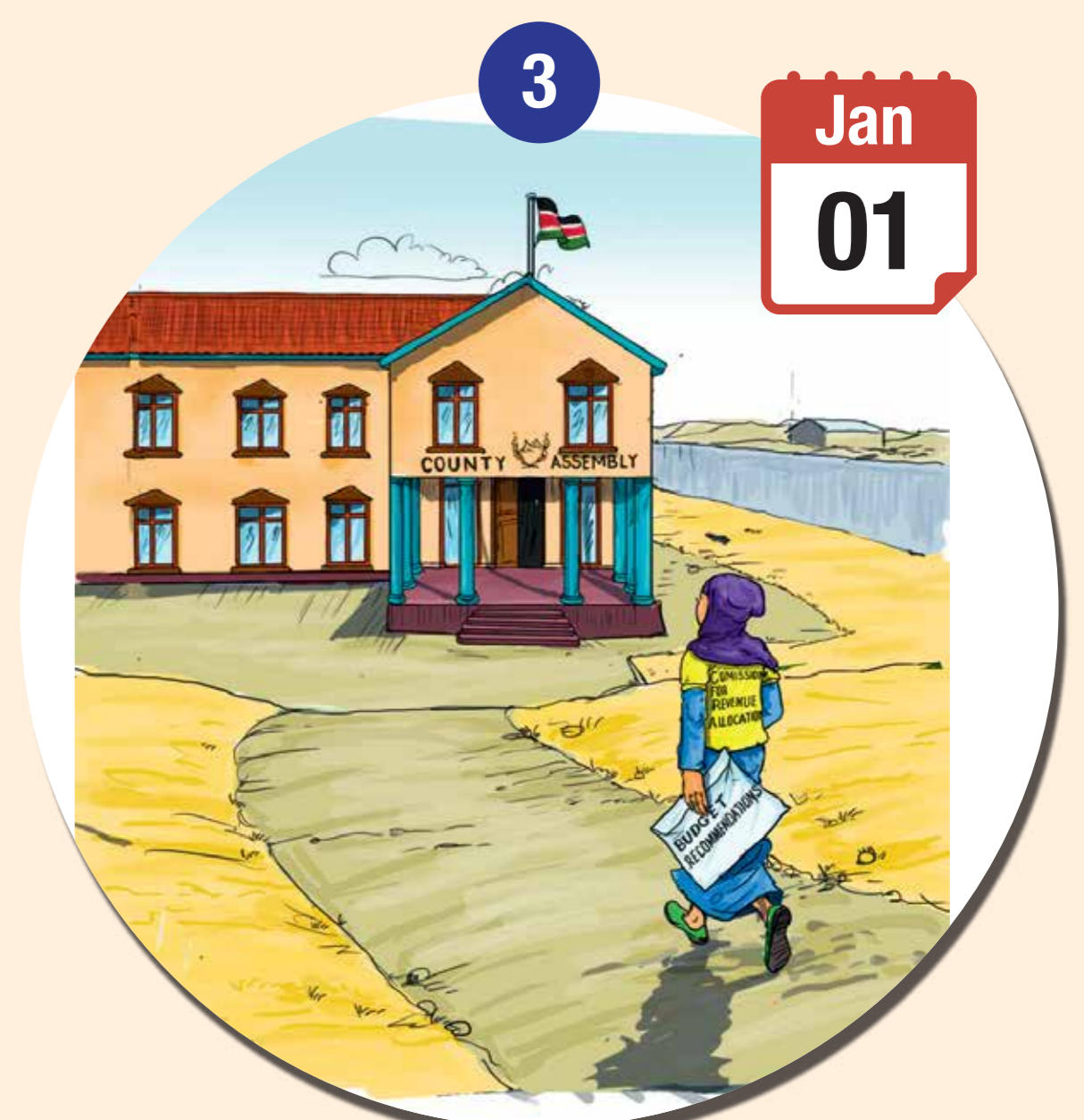
Budget Review and Outlook Papers tabled in County Assembly to review previous years' budget performance; provide economic outlook and propose provisional sectoral ceilings
